# TTU SUMMER PROGRAM

## > Additional Information about the program



- The TTU Summer Program is a non-profit program contracted by the families directly from Texas Tech University (USA).
- The schools, the National Coordination of TTUHS in Brazil, or High School Serviços Educacionais are not legally responsible for this program. Instead, they act as non-profit facilitators in Brazil, providing information and helping organize the program.
- During their stay, students must have a valid passport, a valid US Tourist Visa and a valid International Health Insurance. Families must provide those items.
- Families are responsible for selecting and buying the air tickets of their choice in a way that the students arrive in Austin, TX, in the morning of July 02, 2012.
- TTU representatives will be welcoming those students at the Austin Bergstrom International Airport (Austin, TX) in the morning of July 02. TTU takes responsibility for the students from that moment until July 13, 2012, when the students will be taken to the Lubbock International Airport to take their flights either back to Brazil or to somewhere else, according to the families' individual choices and itineraries.
